- A **Call Committee** has been appointed by Council consisting of the following members: Dolly Whelan, Kelley Lund, Melissa Strom, Mitch Kiffe, Mark Spoto, Austin Grisard, and Bill Carbaugh. The Call Committee recently had a kickoff meeting with the Rev. Sarah Garrett Krey, who serves as the Assistant to the Bishop for Mobility and Candidacy for the DC Synod. Pastor Sarah urged the Call Committee to let the Holy Spirit guide them in the Call Process and said that the committee should be receiving resumes to review soon. The Call Committee is tasked to work together in confidence to interview pastoral candidates and unanimously submit a candidate for Council approval. Once approved by Council, the candidate would then be introduced to and voted on by the Congregation before being presented with the Call to be the next Pastor of Christ the King. The Call Committee will provide periodic updates as it moves through the Call process.
